The Court may refuse to consider memos filed late, may preclude oral argument on the motion or may impose sanctions for failure to comply.

ALL MOTIONS TO CONTINUE MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING NOT LESS THAN 4 BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE THE DATE SET FOR MOTION HEARING. Counsel cannot assume that uncontested motions to continue will be automatically granted.

Counsel are expected to notify the Clerk immediately upon learning that a matter is settled, withdrawn, or will not be contested.
